Made With Love Treat Bag

Supplies

Stamps: [Made With Love Suite Collection \(English\)](#) [167079]

Ink: [Real Red Classic Stampin' Pad](#) [147084]

Paper: [Real Red 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock](#) [102482], [Flirty Flamingo 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock](#) [141416], [Gold Foil Sheets](#) [132622], [Hearts Gusseted Treat Bags](#) [167073]

Tools & Adhesive: [Multipurpose Liquid Glue](#) [110755], [Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine](#) [149653], [Paper Trimmer](#) [152392]

Measurements For Gusseted Bag:

- Flirty Flamingo: 3" x 3"
- Real Red: 5/8" x 2-1/2"
- Gold Foil: 5/8" x 2-1/4"

Made with Love 12" x 12" DSP:



• 3-3/4" x 6"



• 3-1/2" x 3-1/2"

Instructions:

- Die cut the tag heart from Flirty Flamingo cardstock.
- Die cut the label from Real Red Cardstock. Run through again to cut hearts from the tag.
- Die cut the small arrow from Gold Foil.
- Stamp "To:" and "X" and the heart in Real Red on the upper corner of the heart.
- Attach the 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" DSP to the larger piece with liquid glue.
- Poke a hole in the center of the DSP approximately 1/2" down from the top.
- Thread Bubble Bath ribbon through the hole. Add the Tag and the label with the DSP. Tie off at the top of the DSP.
- Attach the DSP panel to the front of the Hearts Gusseted Treat Bag below the bottom score line - use adhesive on the DSP below the hole you put ribbon through.
- Slip the arrow the the hearts on the label and attach. I used both arrows, cut the tip and the fletching off one each. Reconnect the arrows into one piece after Putin through the hearts.
- Put a treat in the bag (I used a small box of chocolates - Russel Stover Assorted) and roll closed like you normally would. Because of the way we attached the DSP, the little tabs will close behind the DSP hiding them for a clean look!





Made With Love Shaker Card

Supplies

Stamps: Made With Love Suite Collection (English) [167079]

Ink: Flirty Flamingo Classic Stampin' Pad [147052], Strawberry Slush Classic Stampin' Pad [165286]

Paper: Real Red 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [102482], Flirty Flamingo 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [141416], Basic White 8 1/2" X 11" Cardstock [166780], Gold Foil Sheets [132622], Window Sheets [142314]

Tools & Adhesive: Multipurpose Liquid Glue [110755], Foam Adhesive Strips [141825], Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine [149653], Paper Trimmer [152392], Stampin' Dimensionals [104430]

Measurements For Shaker Card:

- Real Red: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" score at 4-1/4"
- Flirty Flamingo: 4-1/8" x 5-3/8"
- Gold Foil: 3-7/8" x 4"
- Basic White: 4" x 5-1/4" (inside panel), scraps for stamping
- Window Sheet: 3-7/8" x 4-1/2" (x2)

Made with Love 12" x 12" DSP:



- 4" x 5-1/4"

Instructions:

- Attach the DSP to the Flirty Flamingo cardstock. Only on the edges.
- Die cut the large heart from the upper half of that panel. Add adhesive around the heart if needed to secure the DSP to the Flirty Flamingo (I added a bit of glue at the point of the heart).
- Dry emboss the Flirty Flamingo heart piece with the Hearts Of Love 3D Embossing Folder. *optional - highlight the edges of the heart by brushing Strawberry Slush ink with a blending brush.
- Stamp "Happy" and "Day" onto a scrap piece of Basic White with Flirty Flamingo and "Valentine's" with Strawberry Slush ink. Fussy Cut these out individually.
- Stamp a couple single hearts, "sending you" and "Hugs & Kisses" on the 4" Basic White with Strawberry Slush ink.
- Attach the sentiments to the Flirty Flamingo embossed heart with glue.
- Attach the Bubble Bath ribbon to the bottom of the heart (thread one end of the ribbon through a hole on the border, thread the other end directly opposite) and tie off into a bow.



Instructions (con't):

- Build the shaker portion of the card:
 - Turn the DSP/Flirty Flamingo panel over and attach one of the Window Sheet panels to the Flirty Flamingo with liquid glue or Stampin' Seal.
 - Attach Foam Strips around the actual heart shape on the Window Sheet.
 - Put a scoop of the Loose Valentine Assortments in the center of the foam heart. Spread them out gently so they are not clumped together.
 - The secret trick to this shaker - peel the backing from the foam and attach the second piece of Window sheet to the foam. I found this allows the little assortments to slide around a lot better!
 - Attach the gold foil to the window sheet - only glueing around the heart (glue on window sheets doesn't go well).
- Turn the shaker over and attach to the Real Red card base - glue the gold foil portion and use Dimensionals for the rest to support the height.
- Attach the large Flirty Flamingo heart to the bottom of the card with dimensionals on the top half and glue on the bottom - this makes it look like a lid setting aside.
- Attach some hearts around the sentiments from the Loose Valentine Assortments.
