Paper: [Blackberry Bliss 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock](#) [133675], [Basic White 8 1/2" X 11" Cardstock](#) [166780]

Tools & Adhesive: [Multipurpose Liquid Glue](#) [110755], [Paper Trimmer](#) [152392], [Stampin' Dimensionals](#) [104430], [Bone Folder](#) [102300], [Everyday Arches Dies](#) [164629], [Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine](#) [149653]

Measurements:

- Blackberry Bliss Cardstock: 4-1/4" x 11" score at 5-1/2", 4-1/8" x 5-3/8", 1/4" x 1-1/8", 1/4" x 1-1/2", 1/4" x 1-7/8"
- PP Kit Lantern Card Base: 4-1/8" x 5-3/8", scraps
- PP Kit Starry Sky Card Base: 4" x 5-1/4"
- Basic White Cardstock: 4" x 5-1/4", scraps
- PP Kit Window Panel: see template

Instructions:

- Use the template on page 3 for cutting, scoring and folding details for the windows.
- Attach the 4-1/8" Blackberry Bliss panel and the 4" starry sky panel together and cut the window from the center with the 3-1/4" wide Everyday Arches Die.
- Attach the windows - shortest score fold - to the edges of the back of the window panel.
- Attach the window panel to the Lantern Panel with the very last folds of the scored windows. This will be the "Pop" feature.
- Stamp your sentiment on a scrap piece of Basic White and fussy cut it or die cut it in a banner style, you can also stamp a second sentiment if you want directly in the sky - use Misty Moonlight ink for both. (My sentiment is from the Sweet Words & Labels)
- Attach lanterns inside the window with dimensionals and 1/4" strips of Blackberry Bliss cardstock - see template
- Attach a couple lanterns around the top portion of the window.
- Attach the sentiment to the top of the window with liquid glue.
- Attach a 1/4" x 5-1/4" strip of left over PP Kit card base to the 4" basic white on the left hand side and attach the Basic White to the inside of the Blackberry Bliss card base.
- Attach the entire window panel to the card front.
- Attach a few gems and enjoy the "bouncy" effect!

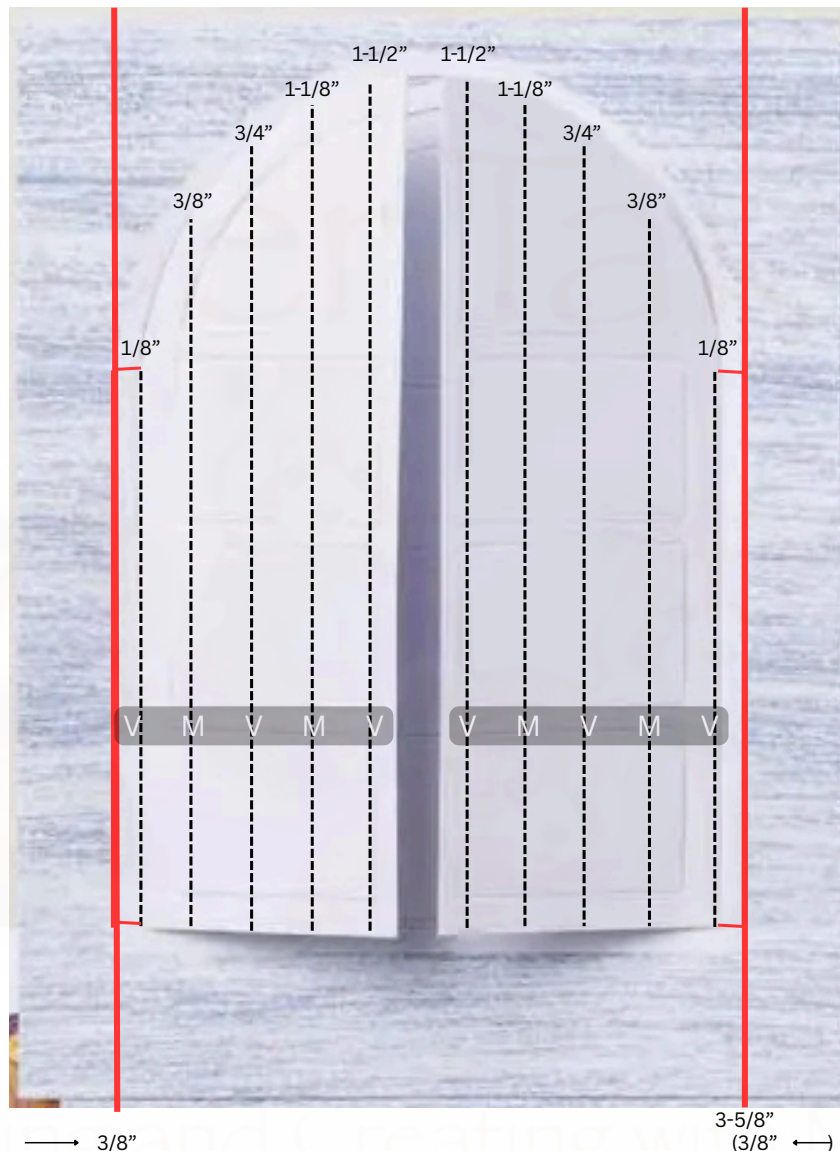
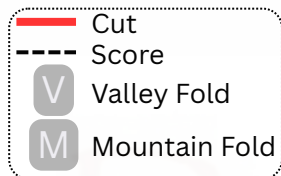
