Supplies:

Stamps: Silly Old Bear Suite Collection [167634]

Ink: Mossy Meadow Classic Stampin' Pad [147111], Cherry Cobbler Classic Stampin' Pad [147083], Golden Glow Classic Stampin' Pad [167676], Pecan Pie Classic Stampin' Pad [161665]

Paper: Basic White 8 1/2" X 11" Cardstock [166780], Early Espresso 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [119686], Mossy Meadow 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [133676], Old Olive 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [100702], Cherry Cobbler 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [119685], Golden Glow 8 1/2" X 11" Cardstock [167685], Pecan Pie 8 1/2" X 11" Cardstock [161717]

Tools & Adhesive: Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine [149653], Multipurpose Liquid Glue [110755], Stampin' Dimensionals [104430], Detail Scissors [170902], Small Blending Brushes [160518], Linen Thread [104199], 2026-2028 In Color™ Dots [167546], Clear Wink Of Stella Glitter Brush [141897]

Measurements:

- Early Espresso Card Base: 5-1/2" x 7" score at 4-1/4", 2" x 2"
- Mossy Meadow: 3" x 5-1/2"
- Old Olive: 1" x 3", 2" x 2"
- Golden Glow: 2" x 2"
- Pecan Pie: 2" x 2"
- Cherry Cobbler: 2" x 2"
- Silly Old Bear DSP: 3" x 4" (scene image), 4-1/8" x 5-3/8", 2" x 6"
- Basic White: 2-3/4" x 5-1/4"

Instructions:

- Stamp your sentiment onto the 1" Old Olive with Mossy Meadow Ink.
- Cut that out with the label die from the Sweet Words & Labels Bundle.
- Cut out the scene image with the coordinating die from the same bundle.
- Cut out leaves from the bundle from Golden Glow, Cherry Cobbler and Old Olive 2" square pieces.
- Cut out the walnut from the Pecan pie and the tops from the Early Espresso 2" square pieces.
- Dry Emboss the 3" Mossy Meadow panel with the Hundred Acre Woods 3D Embossing Folder.
- Stamp the image of Pooh and Piglet from the Sweet Old Friends Set onto the lower left corner of the Basic White panel with Mossy Meadow Ink second generation.



Instructions Con't:

- Darken the edges of the sentiment, leaves and walnuts using blending brushes and the coordinating ink: Old Olive, Cherry Cobbler, Golden Glow and Pecan Pie.
- Use the Pecan Pie ink and brush to add highlights to the edges on the envelope, 2-3/4" Basic White, the 4-1/8" and the 2" DSP panels. Leave the center of the envelope white for writing address.
- Use Wink of Stella on the base of the walnuts to give the realistic shine.
- Use your paper snips and drag down the edges of the Mossy Meadow panel to give it a distressed edge. If needed add more ink to the edging to give it more color.
- Attach the top of the walnuts to their bases.
- Curl the edges of the leaves with your bone folder. You can also curl the edges of the sentiment if you want.
- Attach Linen thread to the back of the image cut out.
- Attach the Mossy Meadow panel to the front of the Early Espresso card base.
- Attach the image piece with the thread to the Mossy Meadow approx. 1.2" from the top with dimensionals, It will over hang the right edge, note that before adding Dimensionals.
- Attach the sentiment below the image with dimensionals in the center and adhesive on the very ends.
- Attach the leaves and walnuts to the top of the image with both adhesive and dimensionals as you feel works best.
- Attach the 2-3/4" Basic White to the 4-1/8" DSP with adhesive.
- Attach the DSP to the inside of the card - when folded you should see DSP on the right side.
- Attach a few Golden Glow dots around the card front.
- Attach the 2" DSP to the left side of the envelope and trim off any access.
